#### **Executive Summary**



#### On MLK day, achieving racial equality remains an essential issue for Americans.

75% of Americans say MLK day is an essential holiday for remembering the importance of US civil rights

57% of Americans say Martin Luther King Jr's legacy is a great speech.

56% say his legacy is a commitment to civil rights.

80% of Americans agree that civil rights are as important in 2021 as at any time in the last 30 years

This is evidenced by 29% of Americans who experienced discrimination in 2020

Over half (53%) of those who experienced discrimination experienced racial discrimination

Nearly half of those who experienced discrimination say it was in their community.

68% say that the COVID-19 pandemic has shown us that America still needs to address education, job and health access inequalities faced by minorities

Employers who want to attract workers in 2021 should embrace Martin Luther King day.

90% of those who say an organization's commitment to diversity would have an impact say MLK Day is an essential holiday

## Half of American workers expect their employer to act on race equality and are proud when they do.

Responsible businesses are one of the top 3 groups that American's believe has made the biggest difference in improving racial equality in the last ten years

50% of American workers expect their employer to act on race equality, 44% on gender, 34% on LGBTQI+

23% of US workers say their employer acted for racial equality in 2020, while 28% say there isn't racism in their organization

46% of US workers say addressing racism in the workplace via HR is the best way to create justice, more than activism or handling racism in the courts or politics

85% who say their employer has acted on racial equality are proud to work there.

That is higher than the 76% who are proud to work in organizations where they say there is no racism.

67% feel proud to work for their employer

Diverse workplaces increase pride to work for an employer

88% who say their company has been and will be committed to diversity and inclusion are proud to work for their employer













Responsible businesses, community leaders and everyday American's have had the most impact on improving racial equality in the last 10 years




23% say their employer has acted on racial equality

85% who say their employer has acted on racial equality are proud to work there.




Did your employer take action in 2020 to address racism where it exists in your organization?






#### The best ways to create justice when Americans feel discriminated against







How proud American's feel to work for their employers when they have the following workplace cultures






Worker's personal experiences affect how they feel about their employer




#### Gender and region representation


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
#### Age representation


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
#### Political views and ethnicity/origin

## Q26 How did you vote in the last Presidential election?





